

#### **7.1.7: THE INSTITUTION HAS DISABLED-FRIENDLY, BARRIER FREE ENVIRONMENT**

##### **POLICY DOCUMENT FOR DIFFERENTLY-ABLED (DIVYANGJAN)**

## Preamble

India has around 80 million people with disability, which may be age related, accident related or due to some medical conditions. According to the World Bank, one in every 12 households in India has a person living with disability. The Indian policy-makers are aware of the issue and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, tried to address some of the concerns faced by differently-abled persons in India. The Act specifically refers to ease of access to public or private buildings, workplaces, commercial activities, public utilities, religious, cultural, leisure or recreational activities, medical or health services, law enforcement agencies, transport infrastructure, among others. In 2015, the Prime Minister rolled out the “Accessible India” (Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan) campaign, with a motive to make it convenient for persons with disabilities to access administrative buildings and transport, among other things. The campaign has been launched in seven States including Delhi and Haryana. The government is also committed towards socio-economic transformation (Swavlamban), of the persons with disability by year 2020 and in this context, India can learn from the global best practices and some of the initiatives taken within the country. At the Workplaces and Educational Institutions, Disabled people found it difficult to access the facilities. Some of the common problems faced by the disabled persons and students are to access the classroom, laboratories, washrooms, upper floors of building, library, play grounds, hostel mess and cafeterias etc. Here some of the policy criterian followed by the institution .

Differently abled (Divyangjan) friendliness resources available in the Institution and “The Learning Disability Friendly Initiative of the Institute”

The right to Education focuses on the need to have inclusive education, which means that educating students with learning difficulties and identified disabilities have the right to fulfilment of their educational needs. The GIET (A) provides equal opportunities to all students.

### 1. OBJECTIVES

- To create inclusive culture to avoid discrimination, exploitation and exclusion of disabled students and staff from all spheres of work and education.
- To create suitable regulatory mechanism for effective delivery of services to Disable Students of the college.
- To ensure implementation of all legislations with respect to persons with disabilities.
- To provide accessible and inclusive education at the Institute.
- To ensure full participation of persons with disabilities and to provide them the equal opportunities for development.

### 2. FACILITIES AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS

a) **Physical Facilities:** The Institute provides ~~RESPECTABLE FACILITIES FOR THE~~ facilities for the differently abled students and persons to provide them opportunities to acquire quality education and to bring them into the main stream of the society. The college has a social responsibility and perception that differently abled

students should be respected and treated as a normal human being.

- b) **Inclusive Curriculum and Teaching Methods:** Encourage faculty members to design an inclusive curriculum that caters to the learning needs of all students. This might involve using diverse teaching methods, providing alternative formats for learning materials, and ensuring that multimedia content is accessible through captions and audio descriptions.
- c) **Faculty and Staff Training:** Conduct regular training sessions for faculty and staff on disability awareness, etiquette, and effective strategies for teaching and supporting students with disabilities. This helps create a more inclusive and empathetic campus culture.
- d) **Physical and Mental Health Support:** Offer counseling services that are sensitive to the mental health needs of students with disabilities. Provide accessible counseling spaces and ensure that counselors are trained to address a diverse range of needs.
- e) **Disability Support Office:** Establish a dedicated office to coordinate support services and accommodations for students with disabilities. Provide information, guidance, and resources for students, faculty, and staff.
- f) **Accessible Online Platforms:** Ensure that all online platforms, including the institution's website, learning management systems, and communication tools, are designed to be accessible to individuals with various disabilities, including those who use screen readers or have mobility impairments.
- g) **Ramps/Rails:** The college has a special facility of ramp and rails for the differently abled students. The main entrances and exits clearly identifiable and easily accessible and it can accommodate wheelchair users. Steps and ramps have hand railings and the entrance permitting access to a conveniently located lift.
- h) **Rest Rooms:** Separate toilets are available for people with disabilities. They are clearly identifiable and accessible. The doors are wide enough and lockable from inside and releasable from outside. There is enough manoeuvring space inside. All floor surfaces are slip resistant. Mirrors, flushing arrangements, dispensers mounted at appropriate heights.
- i) **Provision for Parking:** Parking for people with disabilities is available near the building. This is easily accessible to cross-disability groups equally. The doors should be wide enough to accommodate wheelchair users and the space inside is sufficient for them. \
- j) **Anti-Discrimination Policies:** Develop and enforce policies that explicitly prohibit discrimination, harassment, and bullying based on disability. Ensure that there are effective mechanisms for reporting and addressing such incidents.
- k) **Exam Policy:** Our Institute will make reasonable changes in the educational plan and assessment framework to meet the particular needs of students with disabilities. Sensible convenience will be made to meet the necessities of the considerable number of Students with disabilities. The guidelines and regulations have been issued by the examination department for use scribe in exams.
- l) **Feedback Mechanisms:** Establish channels for students to provide feedback on the accessibility and inclusivity of the institution. Regularly assess the effectiveness of the policy and make improvements based on feedback.
