The following points were discussed, deliberated:

- 1. It is resolved to approve the course structure for GRBT19, B.Tech, EEE as finalized in this meeting which will be followed for the students admitted from academic year 2019-2020 onwards.
- 2. As per considerations from AICTE& APSCHE, the B.Tech course is fulfilled with 160 credits and it is approved by BoS members.
- 3. In 1<sup>st</sup> year, the subject "Basics of Electrical & Electronics Engineering" and a laboratory course of "Basics of Electrical & Electronics Engineering lab" has been introduced for various engineering branches Electronics& Communication Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Science Engineering, Mining Engineering.
- 4. In 1<sup>st</sup> year 1<sup>st</sup> semester for EEE students, a subject **ENGINEERING ELECTROMAGNETICS** is introduced.
- 5. In 1<sup>st</sup> year 2<sup>nd</sup> semester the BEEE subject has been replaced by "ELECTRICAL CIRCUIT ANALYSIS-I" and BEEE lab has been replaced by "ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING LAB" to avoid repetition of content for EEE students.
- 6. In GRBT19, some new **MANDATORY COURSES** are introduced from 1<sup>st</sup> year to 4<sup>th</sup> year. These subjects are evaluated only by internal evaluation.

- 1 Professional ethics & human values in I year I semester
- 2 Environmental studies in I year II semester
- 3 Design thinking & product innovation in II year I semester
- 4 Constitution of India in III year I semester
- 5 IPR & Patents in IV year I semester
- 7 The following subjects are introduced for other departments as OPEN ELECTIVES categorized as 1,2,3,4 and syllabi are finalized for these subjects.
  - 1. Utilization of Electrical energy
  - 2. Energy management
  - 3. Renewable energy resources
- 8 The detailed syllabi for 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year have been reviewed with good inputs from all the external BoS members. The suggestions have been incorporated and the syllabus has been finalized.
- 9 The course structure and detailed syllabi for 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of M.Tech students has been already finalized in earlier BoS meetings and is perused for overall understanding. The same is accepted to be as it is for the students admitted from academic year 2019-2020 onwards.

- 10 The structure and model of internal & external examination question papers for UG programme has been approved.
- 11 The list of Experts for Paper setting in the subjects of UG programme has been approved.
