Points:

- 1. The title of the subject Business Environment is now changed as subject Legal And Business Environment and shifted from I sem to II sem to enable students to easily comperhened the legal environment ..This point was discussed elaborately and it was agreed to by Members..Accordingly, I semester consists of 5+1(open elective)+1(Business Communication Lab)+1(IT-Lab).
- 2. In GRMBA20, the division of marks between External examination and Internal Evaluation shall be 70 marks and 30 marks respectively instead of 60 and 40 marks as was hitherto. After detailed discussions, the following decision was taken regarding setting of Question paper of all subjects:
 - Each Question Paper consists of 6 Questions, out of which the 6th question casestudy is compulsory for all subjects.
 - The remaining 5 questions will consists of Aand B and from each Unit.
 - All five questions carry 12 marks each and case study shall carry 10 marksandtotal maks consists of 70 marks.

In the Internal Evaluation out of 30 marks, 20 marks shall be for the descriptive examination, 5 marks for Report writing and 5 marks for Presentation in each subject. There should be two Internal examinations before the semester examination. The average marks obtained by the student in both internal mid examinations shall be awarded while calculating the grade.

3. The students shall undergo Summer Internship for 5 weeks at the end of II semester and prepare and submit the Project Report at the end of III semester itself instead of IV semester as has been the case at present. The student shall be awarded 100 marks for Project Report instead of Grade hitherto.out of 100 marks, 50 marks shall be awarded for dissertation / Project Report and 50 marks for the Project Viva Voce.

- 1. It was discussed to introduce a subject either Green Marketing or Consumer Behaviour. An eloborate discussion was held and identified the significance of both the subjects. Finally it was adviced to introduce both the subjects in the III Semester, out of which Consumer Behaviour would be the specialization course for the students who are opting for Marketing Management and Green Facets of Management would be the common Audit/ add on course for all the students with 50 Marks and one credit.
- 2. After delibirations, it was agreed to introduce the course of 'Managerial Skills Devolopment' in IV semester as an Audit Course with 50 marks and one Credit .There will be only internal evaluation.
- 3. GRMBA20 offering Dual Specialization: Students can opt any 2 specialization combination out of 7 specializations. One third of the students strength is compuslsory to offer any dual specialization and combination the final decision vests will the Department Acdemic Council.
- 4. The syllabus of III & IV Semesters have been perused by the BOS and discussions were made on variations in syllabus of GR17&GRMBA20 and finalised.
- 5. GRMBA20 Question paper pattern:
- a) Question paper pattern for External Exam: The question paper consists of six questions which carrries maximum of 70 marks. A student shall answer all the 6 questions. Questions from one to five consists of either or questions which carry 12 marks. Sixth question is a Case Study which is compulsory and carries 10 marks.
- b) Question paper pattern for Internal Exam: The Internal examination is meant for 30 marks out of which a student has to appear for 20 marks of discriptive exam (4Q X 5M) and the remaining 10 marks are divided into 5 marks for assignment Report submission and 5 marks are for Seminar presentation.
